Whistleblower Quick Guide

At Ampol, we expect high standards of integrity, honesty, openness and transparency. The Ampol values and the Ampol Code of Conduct embody these standards and guide our dealings and interactions inside and outside the business. So, if you suspect these standards and values are not being upheld, we encourage you to speak up. If you meet the above criteria, you can make a whistleblower report by contacting the Ampol hotline:

Protections for whistleblowers



We will keep your identity confidential if you wish



Protection from retaliation and victimisation for making the report



Protection from liability for making the report



You won't get immunity in relation to conduct revealed by the report



You can also make an **anonymous report**, however if we don't know who you are or can't at least get in touch with you anonymously to obtain additional detail, it may not be possible for us to investigate properly.



If you know or suspect someone else has made a whistleblower report, the law and Ampol policy require you to keep their identity confidential and not mistreat the person in any way because of the report.

Whistleblower protection officer
