Ampol Kurnell Community Fund

We are proud to confirm that, once again, we are providing local community groups and organisations with the opportunity to secure grant funding towards local projects.

The Ampol Kurnell Community Fund provides funding for projects that improve local amenity and positively impacts the lives of Kurnell residents.

Successful applicants in 2022 included the Kurnell Public School for the construction of a new playground, the Kurnell Men's Shed for facility upgrades and Kurnell Project Management Inc for improvements to the Kurnell Horse Arena.



In 2023, Community groups and organisations can apply for funding up to an amount of \$20,000 each.

Applications will be open from 1 August to 15 September 2023 and successful applications will be announced on Friday 24 November.

Odour Study presented to Community Working Group

We engaged one of Australia's leading, independent odour consultants, The Odour Unit, to investigate reports of petroleum like odour in the community. The results were recently presented to the Remediation Community Working Group.

The study was conducted across 113 locations and results included some instances of petroleum like and other indigenous odours. For the petroleum like odour, it is understood, these could be linked to the landfarm, storage tanks in the north-east corner of the Terminal and the separator vents in the wastewater treatment plant.

Initial actions to mitigate petroleum like odour from the Terminal include:

- Landfarm – prioritisation of the removal of material from site (to be completed by August 2023).
- Separator vents – carbon filters installed on vents (completed April 2023).
- Storage tanks – cleaning of oily water sewer and improved drain covers.

We will continue to monitor, make further improvements, and will keep the community informed of our progress.

Test of Incident Notification platform

We will be conducting a test of the incident notification platform at 11am on Monday 24 July.

This platform has been established to provide residents and the community with alerts and information in the event of a major incident at the Kurnell Terminal.

This will be a test only and no action will be required.

Bore Water Sampling Program

We are providing Kurnell residents with the opportunity to participate in the next round of our bore water monitoring program. The program has been conducted every seven years since 1994 and is available free to Kurnell residents who use bore water on their property.

We have engaged Environmental Consultants, WSP to coordinate, collect samples and provide results to residents.

Residents will soon receive a letter with more information on how to participate.

Community support - Sutherland 2 Surf

For well over 10 years, we have proudly supported the Wanda Surf Life Saving Club and their major fundraising event, the Sutherland 2 Surf.

Each year the event attracts close to 6,000 competitors and raises valuable funds for the purchase of vital lifesaving equipment, including rescue tubes, inflatable rescue boats and rescue boards.
