Kurnell landfarm

In 2022, an independent study conducted by "The Odour Unit" identified the landfarm as a key source of odour due to wet hydrocarbon sludge that was stored at this location.

Since mid-2022 we have expedited the drying of this material and are pleased to confirm that all material has now been removed from the site.

Moving forward, the landfarm will no longer be used and is now in the process of being decommissioned, which involves removal of the landfarm liner and bunding.

We continue to make improvements across the site to mitigate impact from our operations and we will keep you updated of our progress.

We recently advised in our August 2023 Kurnell Community Update, that a strategic review is being carried out to look at what opportunities exist for a section of remediated land at our Kurnell site. Aligned to our Future Energy and Decarbonisation strategies, one option we are exploring is a grid scale battery.
